We do not provide warranty coverage for any damage to surfaces resulting from incorrect removal or installation of the product.

If the product is used continuously for 24 hours a day, it will void the warranty. Please adhere to the recommended usage guidelines to ensure the best performance and longevity of the product.

Lastly, please be aware that the warranty only covers manufacturing defects. If any issues arise due to manufacturing defects, please reach out to us or your authorized dealer for assistance.

- 1. Before starting the installation, ensure that the power is turned off. This is important for your safety and to prevent any electrical accidents during the installation process.
- 2. It is crucial to have the installation performed by a certified person. This helps ensure that the product is correctly installed and reduces the risk of any potential issues or hazards.
- 3. The light source in this luminaire is not replaceable. Once the light source reaches its end of life, the entire luminaire should be replaced. Do not attempt to replace the light source separately.
- 4. This product is designed for indoor use only. Do not install it in outdoor or damp locations, as it may not be suitable for such environments and could lead to safety hazards.
- 5. If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it should only be replaced by the manufacturer, their authorized service agent, or a qualified person with similar expertise. This ensures that the replacement is done correctly and reduces the risk of hazards.
- 6. The cable or cord should be attached in such a way that any future replacements can only be made by the manufacturer, their authorized service agent, or a qualified person. This ensures that the installation remains secure and avoids any potential safety issues.
- 7. Please follow these instructions carefully during the installation process to ensure proper usage and safety. If you have any further questions or concerns, don't hesitate to contact the dealer, local vendor, or manufacturer for assistance.

USAGE GUIDELINES/MAINTENANCE

Perform maintenance when the power supply is cut off and the product has cooled down to ensure safety and prevent accidents or burns. Use only soft and dry cloths for cleaning. Avoid chemical detergents that may damage surfaces or components. Gentle cleaning with a dry cloth is sufficient. Do not cover the product during operation or when turned off. Maintain free air access for proper ventilation and to prevent overheating. The product may heat up during operation, which is normal for electronic devices. Install it in a well-ventilated area with sufficient space for effective heat dissipation.

MOUNTING




Read the manual before mounting. Mounting should be done by a qualified electrician. Exercise caution during the process. The product has a protective contact/terminal. Ensure the protective lead is connected to prevent electric shock. Refer to the mounting diagram/pictures provided. Check for proper mechanical fastening and electrical connection before the first use.

INSTALLATION DIAGRAM

3. Hold the two clips back against the panel light and push it


into the hole. Allow the springs to pull the light up to the ceiling.



4. Check whether the lamp is flat and electrified.

Clean the lamp with clean cloth.

6. Switch on the power and test the light.
